



2012-2013 SUPREME COURT CASES OF INTEREST TO LAW ENFORCEMENT

During its recently completed term, the US Supreme Court decided several cases of interest to law enforcement.

SEARCH & SEIZURE

The Court decided two cases involving the use of a police dog.

Chiefs should let their K-9 officers know that a warrant is necessary for using a trained police dog within the curtilage of a person's home. Traditionally, we have taught K-9 Officers that they can bring their dog wherever the officer is legally entitled to go. If the dog detects drugs, explosives or other items for which it is trained, an "alert" generally provides probable cause to take some enforcement action. Things have changed a little as a result of the Supreme Court's decision in the case of Florida v. Jardines. Now courts may look at the reason the officer and dog are in a given location. This is because, in this case, a divided Court ruled that bringing a trained police dog onto someone's porch for the purposes of obtaining evidence with which to secure a search warrant is a search in violation of the Fourth Amendment. This should not affect the practice of using a dog to sniff the exterior of a lawfully stopped motor vehicle, luggage on busses or trains, or other uses that do not involve a person's home.

In Florida v. Harris

the Court was unanimous regarding another Florida case and the use of a trained narcotics dog. Contrary to what the Florida Court concluded, the Supreme Court ruled that extensive field records on the dog's performance in training, including records for the dog's false alerts, are NOT necessary to establish the dog's reliability for probable cause. Rather, a drug detection dog's certification by way of training records are sufficient to establish that dog's reliability with respect to probable cause. This is in keeping with the general practice followed by courts in this area of the country it seems. Chiefs should caution K-9 Officers not to become complacent, however, as trial judges still have some discretion as to what questions may be asked and what documents must be produced. Handlers should be prepared to show not only training records, but also some documentation of the dog's performance record. Chiefs should periodically require handlers to demonstrate that they and their furry friend are current on all certifications and training records.

In Bailey v. United States

a divided Court held that the authority to detain a suspect pursuant to the execution of a search warrant must be limited to the immediate vicinity of the location to be searched. The case involved the conviction of a Long Island man who had been detained when police chased his vehicle after he fled from his house just before it was to be searched. In Michigan v. Summers, 452 U.S. 692 (1981), the Court adopted a rule that officers executing a search warrant for contraband may detain the occupants of the premises while the search is conducted based on the following justifications: (1) the legitimate law enforcement interest in preventing flight in the event that incriminating evidence is found, (2) the interest in minimizing the risk of harm to the officers, and (3) the orderly completion of the search, which may be facilitated if the occupants of the premises

are present. The Court concluded that once Bailey had driven away none of the law enforcement interests the Michigan case identified were involved.

In Bailey, the officers followed the two individuals for approximately 5 minutes or one mile, and then pulled the men over. They ordered the men out of the car and conducted a pat down search, which turned up no weapons or contraband. The officers then seized the driver's keys and handcuffed both men. The officers told them men that they were not under arrest, but were being detained incident to the execution of the search warrant. The officers drove the two men back to the apartment, which by then had been secured and searched by other officers. The search discovered multiple guns, ammunition, drugs and drug paraphernalia. Both men were then formally placed under arrest.

Chiefs should arrange to have all officers (especially detectives) advised of this change in the law. While persons in a place to be searched can be detained, once such individuals have left the premises, unless they are in the "immediate vicinity," such as in the yard or walking down the driveway, officers will need an independent basis to stop and search them.

In Missouri v. McNeely

the Court split 5-4 with the majority holding that the drawing blood without a warrant or a person's consent violates the person and therefore violates their Fourth Amendment rights. The Court refused to make a general exception regarding drunk driving incidents and warrantless blood draws and stated that a "totality of the circumstances" analysis should still be conducted on a case-by-case basis. Chiefs should be sure that all officers involved in drunk driving enforcement are aware that blood may not be drawn for enforcement purposes unless the suspect voluntarily consents or a court order (search warrant) is secured.

Finally, in Maryland v. King the majority approved of the constitutionality of Maryland's DNA Collection Act, which authorizes law enforcement officers to collect DNA from persons charged with violent crimes or burglary while they are in custody. The Court reasoned that suspects in custody have lower expectations of privacy and equated the harmless cheek swab with fingerprinting, a legitimate police procedure employed for decades. Chiefs should check with their local prosecutors or state Attorney General's office to determine what is allowed or required by their state law. The Maryland case allows but does not require the collection of DNA.

SPEEDY TRIAL & ASSISTANCE OF COUNSEL

In Alleyne v. United States

another 5-4 decision, the Court once again, as it has over the past 30 or so years, revisited the question of whether fact-finding that increases the mandatory minimum sentence is a right conferred in the jury by the Sixth Amendment. The Court held that a fact that increases even the mandatory minimum sentence is an element of the crime that must be submitted to a jury.


The Supreme Court found that the question of whether or not the accused had brandished his weapon during the robbery was not merely a "sentencing factor," which the judge could unilaterally decide, but an "ingredient of the offense," which must be assessed and decided upon by the jury. This finding contradicts the court's finding in a previous case, Harris v. United States (2002), thereby overruling that case.




This case is of more interest to prosecutors than line police officers.



CODE OF ETHICS

For Police Executives

NEW ENGLAND ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE, INC.



We, members of the New England Association of Chiefs of Police, Inc., recognizing our responsibilities to the communities we serve and our obligations to society in general and with the knowledge that our profession requires the highest ideals and rules of conduct, hereby adopt the following code of ethics for police executives, and commend them to all persons in the police profession for their guidance.

We will put honesty, truth and justice above all other considerations, and we will not allow friendship, enmity, social position, political influence, nor personal motives to swerve us from the impartial performance of duty.

We will neither solicit nor accept, any gift, privilege, favor or advantage from any person which will place us under any obligation to overlook any violation of a law, or violate the ethics of our profession.

We will observe all the provisions of the Constitution of the United States, and will never illegally deprive any person of any right guaranteed by the great document. We will not become involved in any social, political, or religious controversy except as neutral agents of the public, and we will at all times endeavor to carry out the desires of the majority of citizens as legally expressed through proper legislative, judicial or executive channels of government.

Having efficient police administration as our objective, we recognize the need for professional fitness on the part of police executives and subordinates. We pledge ourselves to advance the science of police service through training courses and other methods adequate to meet the proper requirements of our profession.

Recognizing the mutual dependence of all law enforcement and social agencies, we pledge our cooperation to all officials and agencies interested in the promotion of justice and the improvement of social conditions. We will not allow envy, jealousy, or any other motive to interfere with such cooperation.

We will be fair with subordinates showing only that favor which has been honestly earned by meritorious service to the public: demanding that all police officers perform their duties and enforce the laws with impartiality, judgment and courtesy.

We recognize our responsibility to the press as a medium through which the public we serve can be kept informed of our activities. We solicit its support in all honest police endeavor, and its condemnation of any act or policy detrimental to the best interests of society. We deplore violations of the code of ethics for journalism in connection with publication of police news and respectfully recommend observance of that code.
